# Toll brothers motion to quash denied!

Mar 17, 2016 — We received the happy news that Judge Grine denied the quash motion from Toll brothers. This means that we can proceed with our lawsuit.

Judge Grine noted that the Toll brothers project is in violation of Ferguson township's zoning ordinance.

Grine specifically held that the appeal was timely, because the Final PRD approved by the Ferguson Township Board of Supervisors on November 16, 2015 did not comply with all the conditions of approval in the Tentative PRD, and he specifically held that the plaintiffs have standing because they actively participated in the underlying proceedings and are “directly and adversely affected by Appellee Board’s decision”.
